Subject: Letter of motivation for application to be re-elected in the Executive Committee of WFHSS

Dear Dr. Christine Denis,

As soon as I started to work as an Expert in Sterile Medical Devices in the Amsterdam University Medical Centers in Amsterdam in 2009 I realized and emphasized that the role of the CSSD department in taking care of the reusable medical devices, is crucial to ensure that every patient is treated with high quality, clean and sterile medical devices. The people working in the CSSD are therefore, to my opinion, very important for the safety of the patients in our hospitals.

Since I started this career, the medical devices became not only more complicated in their design, they also are being minimalized in size and diameter making it even harder for the CSSD departments to return save to use medical devices to the caretakers that uses these devices.

Internationally I have had the opportunity to see how other countries are working in the CSSD departments, how they develop their methods, how they invent ways to coop with the daily problems they meet and how they struggle with the recognition of their important role in patient care in the hospitals. By sharing experience and education we can learn from each other all over the world.

The reasons to apply for re-election for the role in the Executive Committee of the WFHSS are:
Helping to make sure that the available information is exchanged between the different countries and CSSD departments

Helping the member countries to support and develop international harmonized standards so everybody can work in the (more or less) same way based on evidence and best practices, knowing that they fully service the patients of the hospitals the way they might expect from the hospitals.

Helping to get the worldwide recognition of the CSSD departments in the hospitals. With this recognition they can play an even more important role in the process of buying new medical devices so they can PREVENT possible problems instead of finding a way to solve the unexpected problems they are being confronted with, once the medical devices are bought, used and brought to the CSSD departments for cleaning and disinfection.

Helping to organize the yearly WFHSS congress so people that will attend this meeting can be sure that they can make a positive move in their professional development by getting the correct information from renowned speakers in scientific sessions and that they will be up to date with the reality of this moment and what can be expected in the future.

Helping the member countries to implement the theoretical knowledge in their daily practice by supporting the training program, making countries and CSDD departments enthusiastic

for this program and to get motivated to host the participants in their department to attend the practical training program


