



WFHSS scholarship commitments

The applicant commits to:

During the annual congress:

- Introduce themselves to all members of the WFHSS Executive Committee, and especially to their designated mentor
- Attend the WFHSS General Assembly
- Introduce themselves at the General Assembly: association, country, professional background, current position
- Attend all conferences (not less than 80%)
- Visit supplier booths

After the annual congress:

- Draw up a detailed report of possible improvements heard about in the congress that can be implemented in his/her country, establishment, or for a group of establishments in the field of cleaning and disinfection, packaging, sterilisation, logistic, quality management, flexibles endoscopes
- Identify training courses in his/her country that could be implemented in partnership with WFHSS experts
- Identify 3 national Key Opinion leaders as potential partners: professional background, positions held, public or private sector
- Identify 3 institutions (public, private) likely to implement the proposed improvements
- Submit a detailed report to their designated mentor about the improvements that could be implemented in reprocessing units within 3 months after the congress is finished
- Provide a reasonable timetable for the implementation of the key actions identified
- On demand of WFHSS EC, attend one of the next WFHSS congresses to tell the attendees about the visit and what improvements have been done in the home country
