The Polish Association of Medical Sterilisation (PSSM) is the only professional organization of its kind in Poland, making it the natural representative of the country within the global sterilisation community. With 544 active members, PSSM brings together professionals dedicated to advancing medical device reprocessing, sterilisation and infection prevention.

For more than 15 years, PSSM has played a leading role in the development of medical sterilisation in Poland. Through its educational activities, the Association has supported the professional training of medical sterilisation technicians, contributed to the development of national guidelines and best practices for decontamination and sterilisation, and promoted the highest standards of patient safety. Today, PSSM continues to organize nationwide and regional scientific meetings, specialist training courses, and hands-on workshops, creating a strong platform for education, innovation, and professional exchange.

Building on this experience, PSSM is highly motivated to host the World Sterilisation Congress in Poland. Bringing the congress to Poznań would not only showcase Poland's achievements in medical sterilisation, healthcare, and medical research, but also create new opportunities for international collaboration, scientific exchange, and encourage the sharing of best practices. The Association is committed to delivering an outstanding congress that will strengthen the global sterilisation community, foster lasting professional partnerships, and leave a meaningful legacy for healthcare professionals in Poland and around the world.

As the Poznań bidding team, we are committed to organising a congress that will be scientifically enriching, financially sound, and beneficial for all stakeholders. We are confident that hosting the World Sterilisation Congress in Poland will provide an excellent platform for international knowledge exchange, foster new scientific and professional collaborations, and facilitate the sharing of best practices in medical sterilisation and infection prevention.

Furthermore, we undertake to enter into the necessary contractual arrangements with the appointed PCO and to pay the agreed fees for its services in accordance with the applicable contract and payment schedule.

Furthermore, bringing the Congress to Poland will significantly increase the visibility of WFHSS within the Polish healthcare community, strengthen cooperation between Polish and international professionals, and encourage greater participation and membership within the Federation.

Hosting the World Sterilisation Congress in Poznań will not only showcase Poland's achievements in healthcare, medical sterilisation, and medical research, but will also leave a lasting legacy by inspiring future generations of professionals and strengthening the global sterilisation community. Proposed venue

The proposed venue for the World Sterilisation Congress 2028 is **the Poznań Congress Center (PCC) or exhibition halls 7, 7A and 8A at the Poznań International Fair (MTP Poznań Expo).**

The Poznań Congress Center forms part of the MTP Poznań Expo complex, comprising 13 exhibition halls with a total area exceeding **150,000 m²**, making it one of the largest congress and exhibition centres in Poland. The venue has extensive experience in hosting international congresses and exhibitions for up to **12,000 participants** and offers comprehensive in-house services, including AV/ICT support, stand construction (IDEA Expo) and catering companies that have been providing their services for congresses and events of up to 12 000 participants. In addition, we also have a complex of six restaurants on our premises – GARDEN City restaurants – for up to 650 pax simultaneously.

The proposed venues fully meets the organisational requirements of the World Sterilisation Congress and also provides excellent capacity for future growth, including more than eight additional meeting rooms and over 110,000 m² of exhibition space. Further details can be found in the bid book on pages 23-54.

The venue's professional operations team is fluent in English and has extensive experience in delivering large-scale international scientific events.

Venue accessibility

The Poznań Congress Center is centrally located and easily accessible by public transport. It is situated directly opposite the Poznań Główny Railway Station and only 6 km (approximately 20 minutes) from Poznań-Ławica International Airport. Further details concerning venue accessibility can be found in the bid book on pages 72-74.

Poznań offers approximately 4,000 hotel rooms within easy reach of the congress venue, ranging from economy to five-star accommodation. Some of the chained brand hotels located nearby: Sheraton hotel 5* (180 rooms), City Park hotel 5* (85 rooms), Mercure Hotel 4* by Accor (228 rooms), Andersia by Radisson 4* (180 rooms), Novotel 4* and Ibis 3* (516 rooms), Hampton by Hilton Poznań Old Town 3* (117 rooms), B&B hotel 3* (156 rooms) as well as other options typically found in other European cities. Further details concerning accommodation in Poznań can be found in the bid book on pages 77-81.

International airport

Poznań's Ławica International Airport (POZ) provides excellent flight connections with multiple direct flights as well as services to airport hubs in Frankfurt, Amsterdam, Dubai, Copenhagen, and Zurich, as well as Warsaw and 46 other direct destinations.

In addition, we have a long-standing relationship with LOT Polish Airlines (Star Alliance Partner), where we can offer significant discounts on LOT for congress delegates. On top of that, we can further negotiate with LOT to provide additional flight connections to Poznań or LOT can provide larger planes based to accommodate additional passengers traveling to/from the Congress. Similar arrangements can be negotiated with other carriers serving Poznań, namely Lufthansa, SAS, KLM, and Swiss Airlines, resulting in wide coverage of delegates travel needs irrespective of destination. 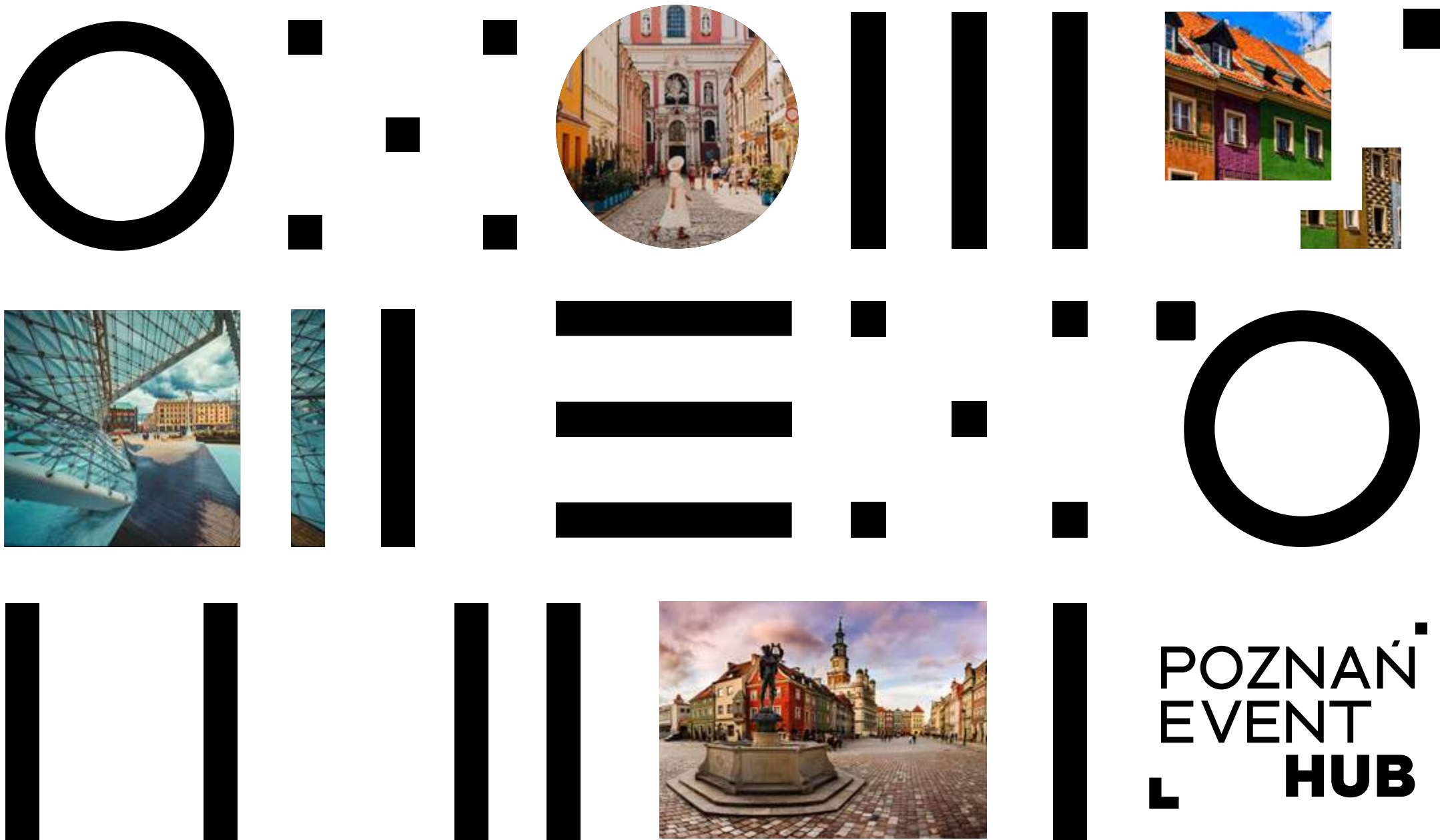

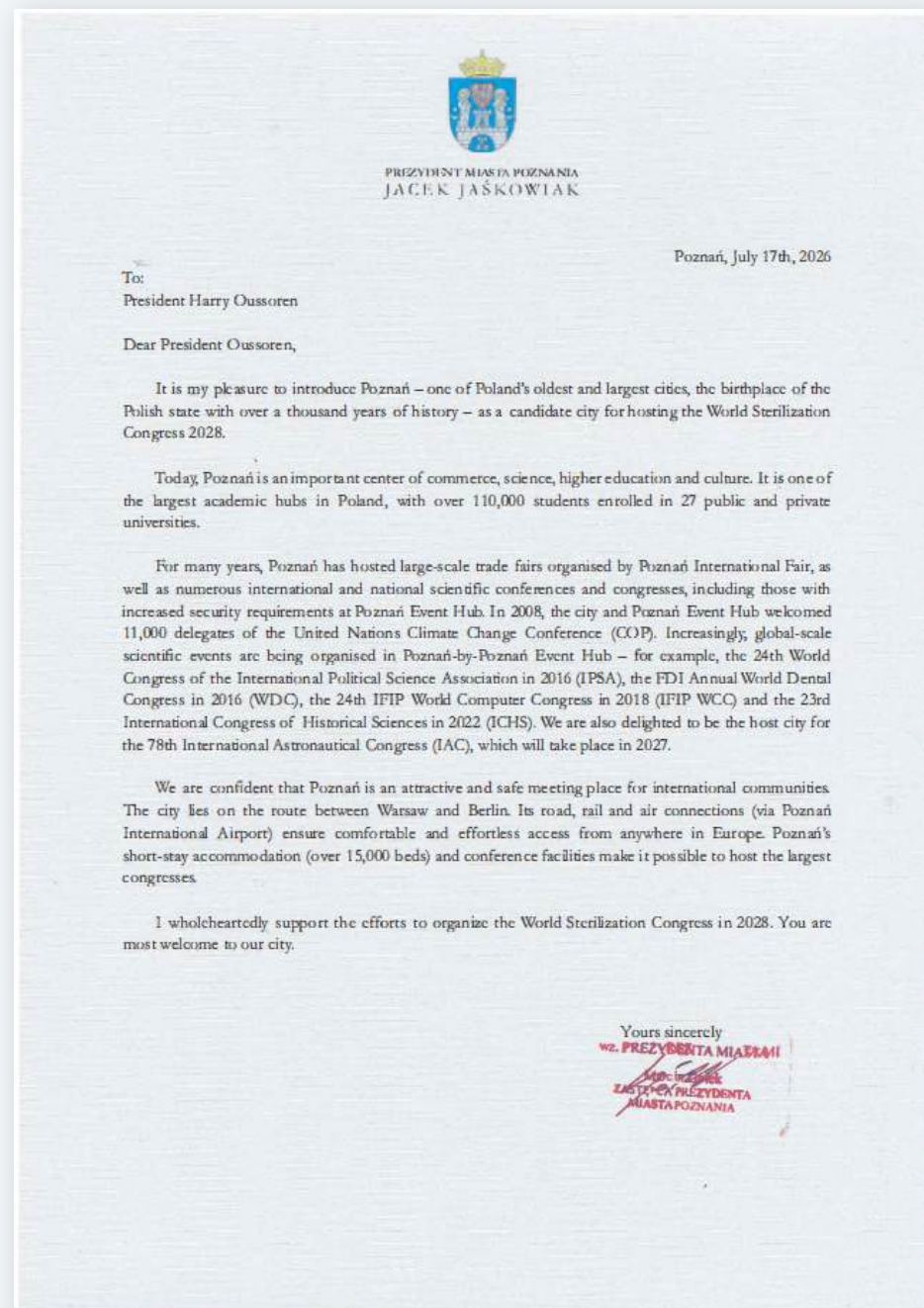

Dear President Onssoren,

We are delighted to learn that the City of Poznań has put itself forward as a candidate to host the World Sterilization Congress in 2028.

From our experience, we know that organizing congresses and conferences is a major organizational and logistical challenge – one for which both the City of Poznań and Poznań Airport (POZ) are well prepared.

Thanks to the reconstruction of the central security control zone, which incorporated the most modern technological solutions, the quality and comfort of passenger service have been improved, increasing the terminal's estimated capacity to over 4 million passengers per year. This means that during peak hours, we can handle approximately 1,900 inbound passengers and 1,100 outbound passengers, while the runway's maximum capacity amounts to 30 flight operations per hour.

During international congresses and conferences held in Poznań, air travelers can benefit from a convenient and continuously expanding network of scheduled flights covering almost all major transit routes (currently 48 direct destinations), including 15 daily flights operated by Star Alliance and SkyTeam carriers such as (KLM, LOT, Lufthansa, SAS, SWISS) to the most important hub airports – Amsterdam, Copenhagen, Frankfurt, Warsaw and Zurich.

In cooperation with airlines, Poznań Airport can also flexibly increase the number of available seats during peak periods (by using larger aircraft or adding extra scheduled flights) and, if necessary, assist in organizing ad hoc charter flights.

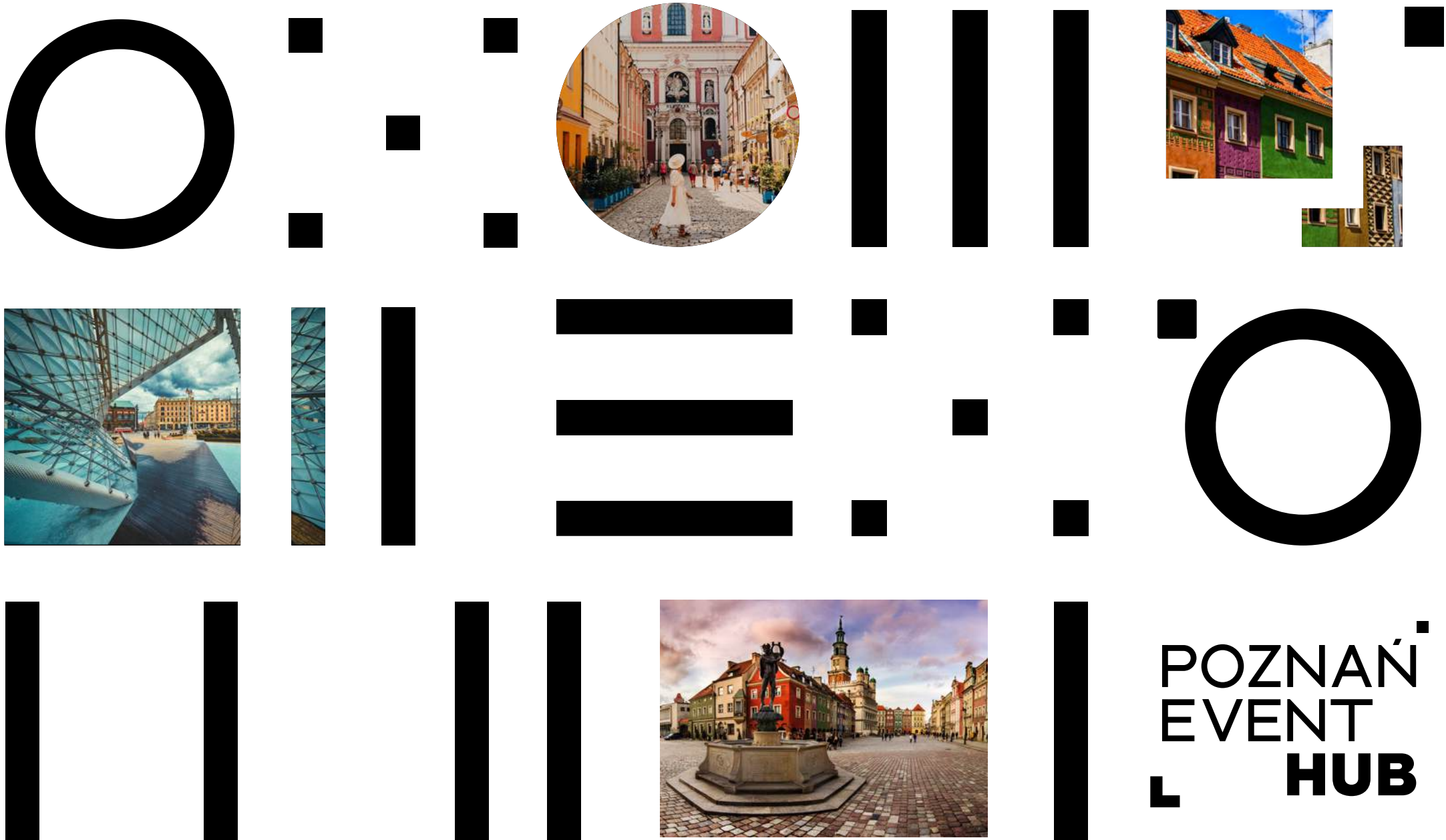

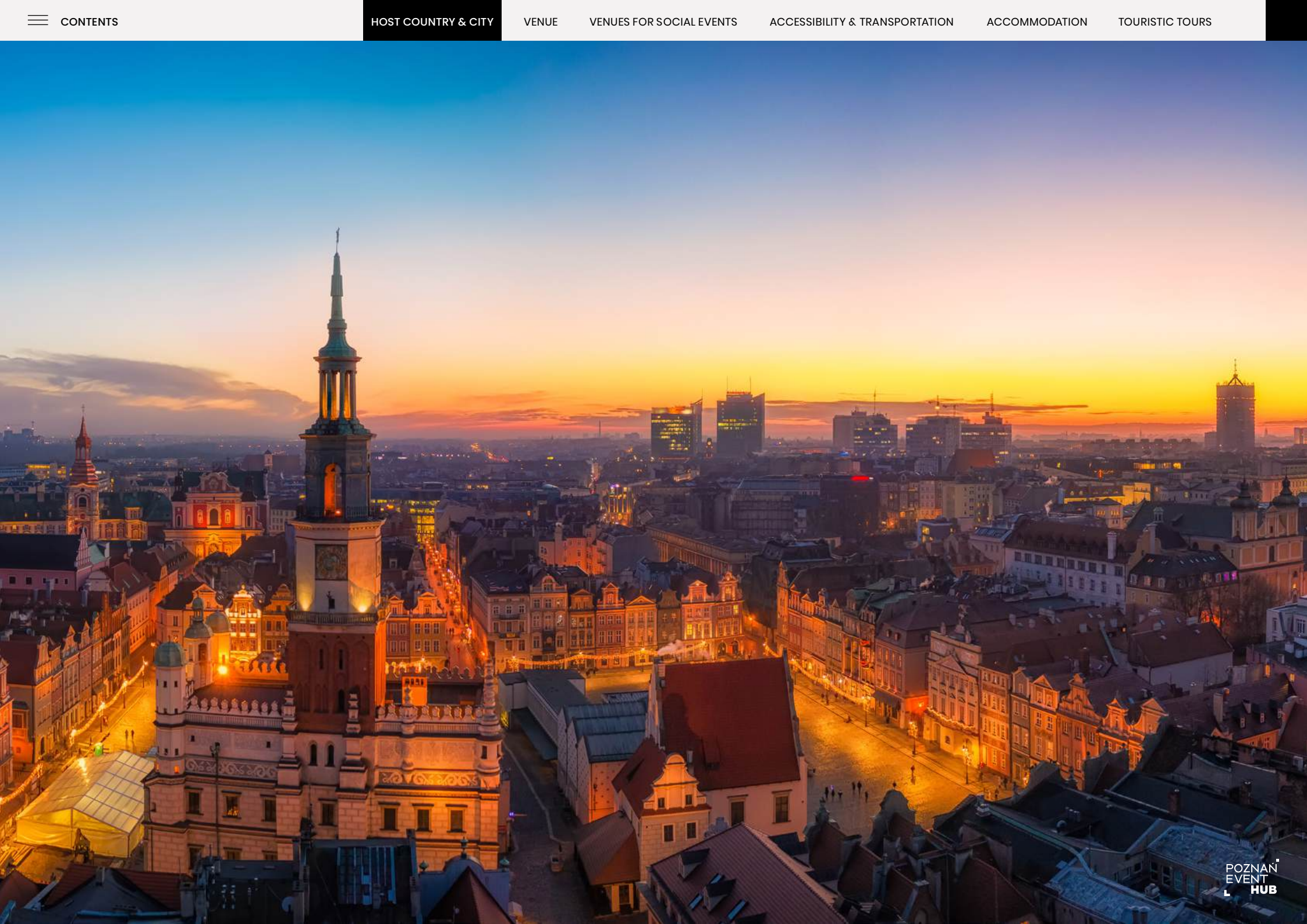

the city's most recognisable landmark is also considered the finest example of Baroque architecture in Poland. Run by the Jesuits, the church was constructed between 1651 and 1701.



The fortified settlement of Biskupin

The Biskupin site – and a life-size model of a late Bronze Age fortified settlement is one of Europe's largest archaeological sites – only 1.5 hours by car from Poznań. It has been included on the list of 100 most important archaeological discoveries of the 20th century.

Net Zero Carbon Events

Grupa MTP is a member of the Polish Chamber of Exhibition Industry that has signed the Net Zero Carbon Events Pledge launched at the COP26, UN Climate Change Conference.

The ICCA Central European Chapter Meeting 2025 served as our pilot project for measuring and reporting the event's carbon footprint. In cooperation with TerGo, we collected and analyzed data in accordance with their methodology, resulting in the publication of an **Event Carbon Footprint Report**.



So far our venue is able to report our carbon footprint according to the GHG Protocol.

Grupa MTP is currently drawing up guidelines which we plan to introduce gradually in the beginning of 2027.

We are a member of **United Nations Global Compact** – a non-binding United Nations pact to encourage

businesses and firms worldwide to adopt sustainable and socially responsible policies, and to report on their implementation. We have made a commitment to make our premises more accessible to the local community.

Therefore, we are redesigning the open space to transform it into a green oasis with pocket gardens that enhance the biodiversity of flora and fauna.

Custom formalities for large medical equipment: Importing large medical equipment into Poland requires compliance with strict EU and national regulations. You must have an EORI number, a valid CE certification, and register the devices in the EUDAMED database. Clearance requires accurate HS codes, a customs declaration (SAD), and strict transport documentation.





Poznań Ławica Airport

Our airport is undergoing further development to be finalised by the end of 2026. During the first stage the airport capacity has been **enlarged from 1100 to 2700 passengers** per hour and 17 000 passengers per day. Second stage will involve the extension of the arrival and departure halls as well as the airport check-in facilities.

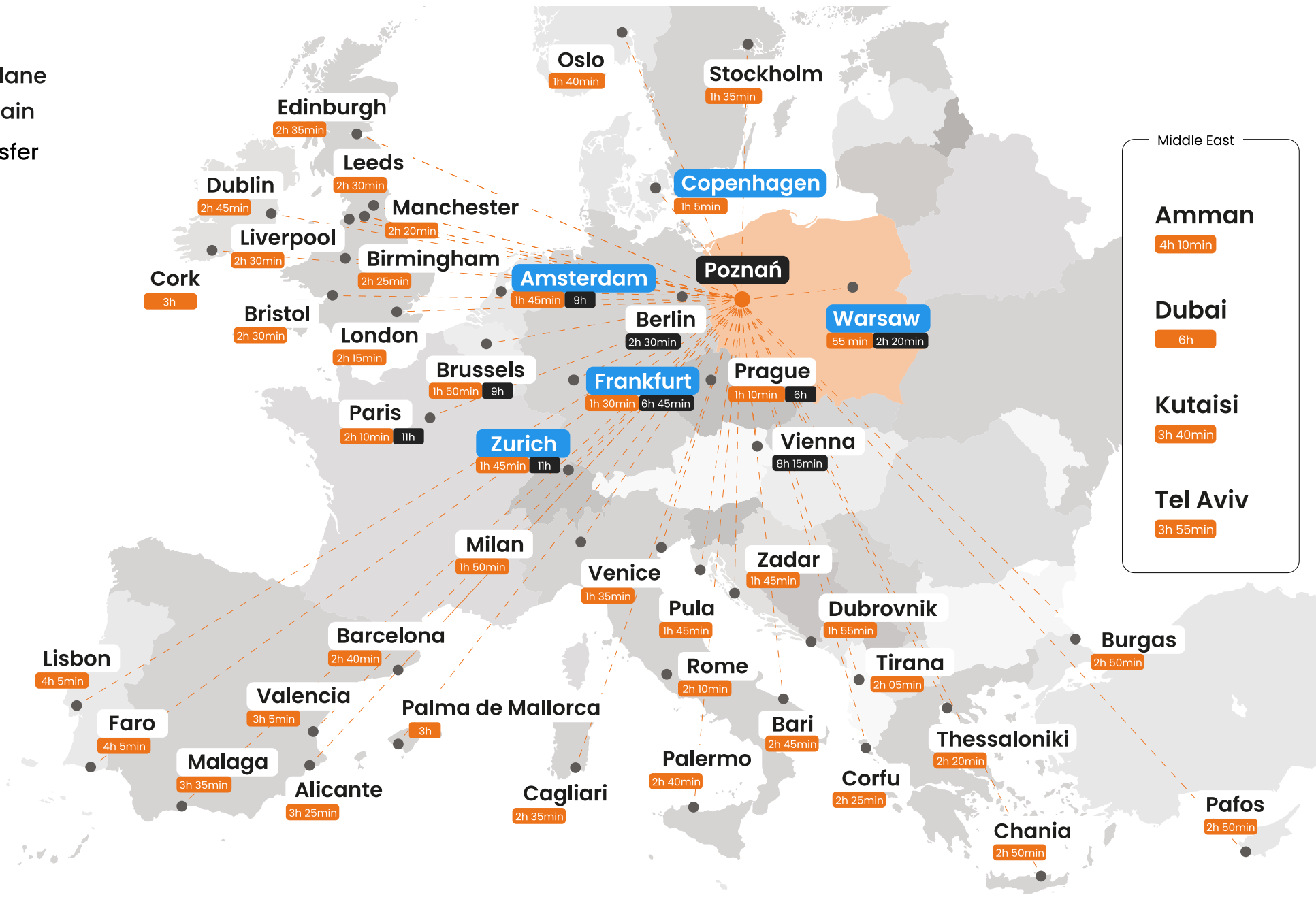

Poznań Ławica Airport modernisation works

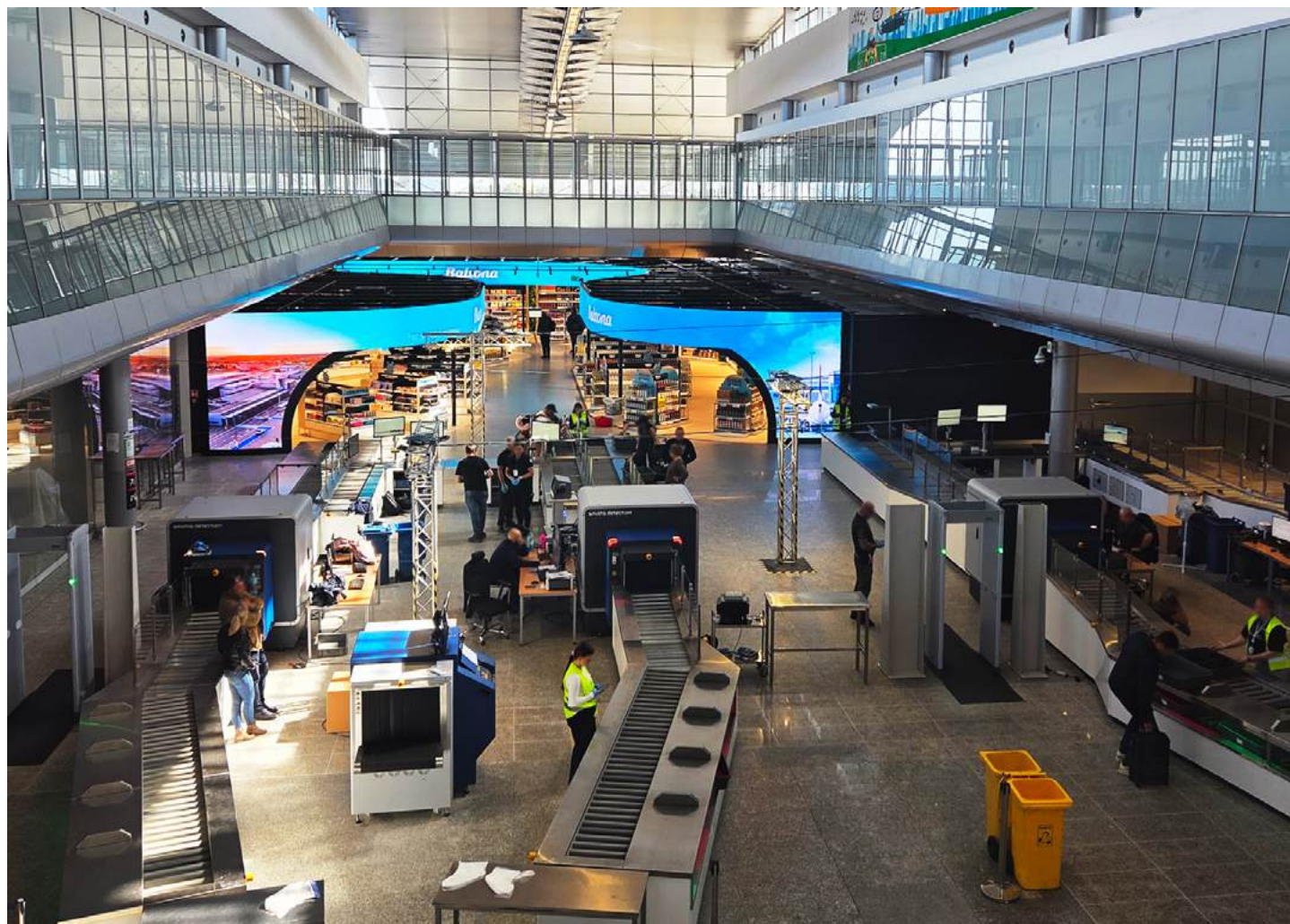
In 2024, the airport's capacity was increased from 1,100 to 2,700 passengers per hour, and from 11,000 to 17,000 passengers per day.

Passengers travelling through Ławica Airport in 2025 can now enjoy faster and more convenient security checks, thanks to newly introduced solutions. Advanced CT scanners with 3D imaging allow liquids in containers of up to 100 ml to remain in hand luggage, without the need to pack them in plastic bags or remove them during screening. The scanners also eliminate the requirement to take out electronic devices. As a result, check-in times are shorter, procedures simpler, and the airport is fully aligned with future EU standards.

Travellers benefit from greater convenience, faster service, and enhanced security—making every journey from Poznań a more comfortable and pleasant experience.

The above modernisation also influences the plans for the development of route network to increase the connectivity of Ławica Airport. Planned new connections include:

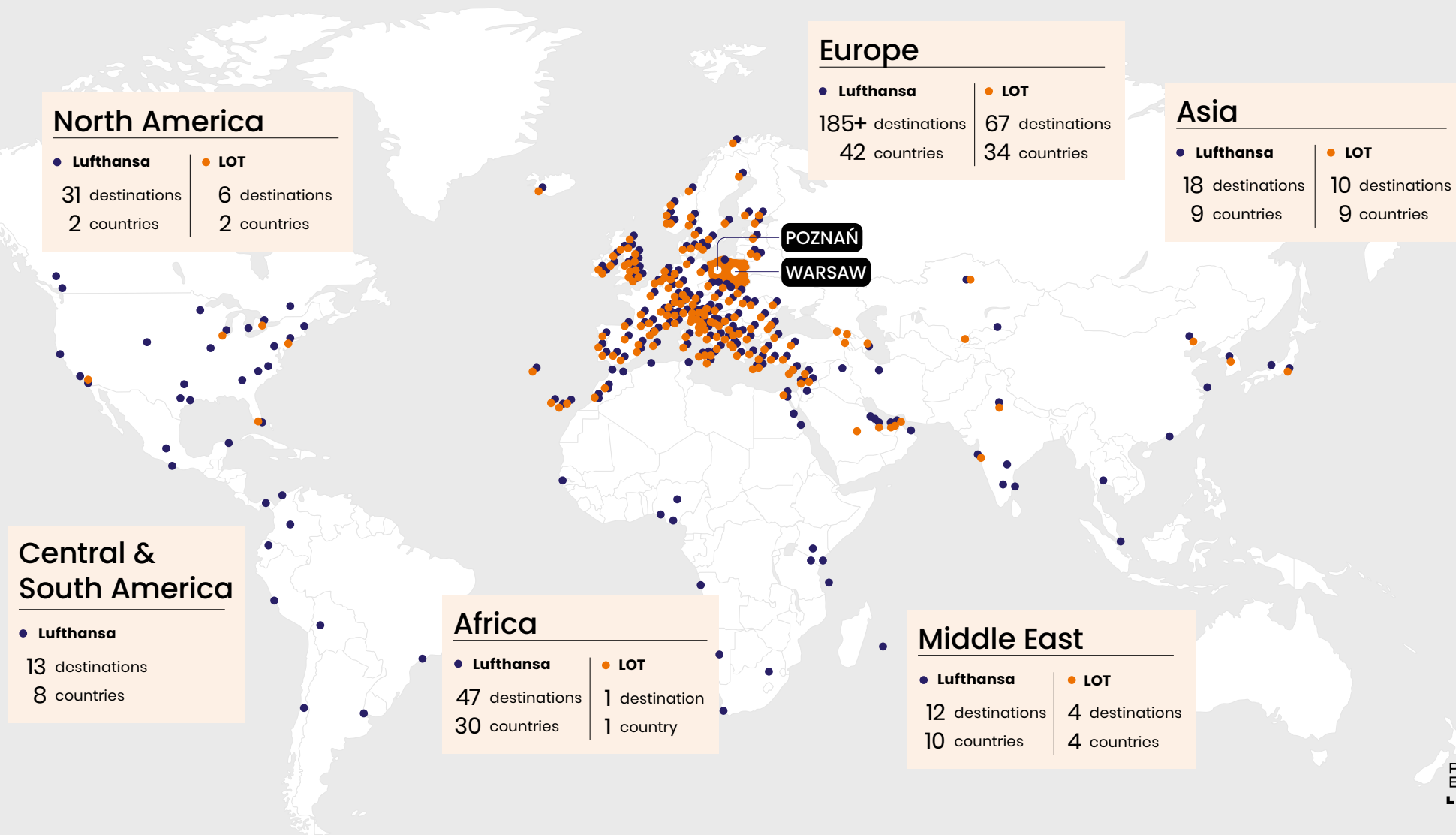
