

Standardize our practices and make it a habit

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In order to enhance communication and collaboration with clinical departments and increase mutual understanding, the CSSD of the 926th Hospital of the PLA Joint Logistics Support Force recently held the International Day of Sterilisation Sciences by "Going out and Walking in" with the theme of "Exploring the Secret of CSSD for Collaboration".



By going out, the department set up a "visiting team" to communicate with the directors, doctors and head nurses of the surgical system, and collected information on the use of medical devices and whether they were satisfied with the sterilization packs. After that, we designed an "immediate solution" platform to collect feedback by scanning the QR code, allowing us to quickly rectify and continuously improve quality.





By walking in, we invited surgeons from various departments and representatives from peer hospitals. First, the head nurse explained the purpose and significance of the activity. In the Decontamination Area, Ren Yaqin performed the returning, classification, cleaning, disinfection and preparatory work of instruments. The importance of processing was explained. Hu Huanmin explained the regional divisions in the Inspection and Packaging Area, the work flow and the importance of biological monitoring. Through on-site visits, practical experience, communication, and sharing sterilization knowledge, everyone could understand the "gorgeous transformation" of contaminated instruments.



Finally, the CSSD prepared an interesting activity called "Let's find faults" to find out the mistakes in the packages, so that everyone could master the sterilization knowledge while playing games. Everyone learned about the tedious and careful work of CSSD. We must build a communication bridge with other departments. We must also be brave in innovation and breakthroughs to build a solid line of defense for the hospital's infection control and ensure the patient safety.
