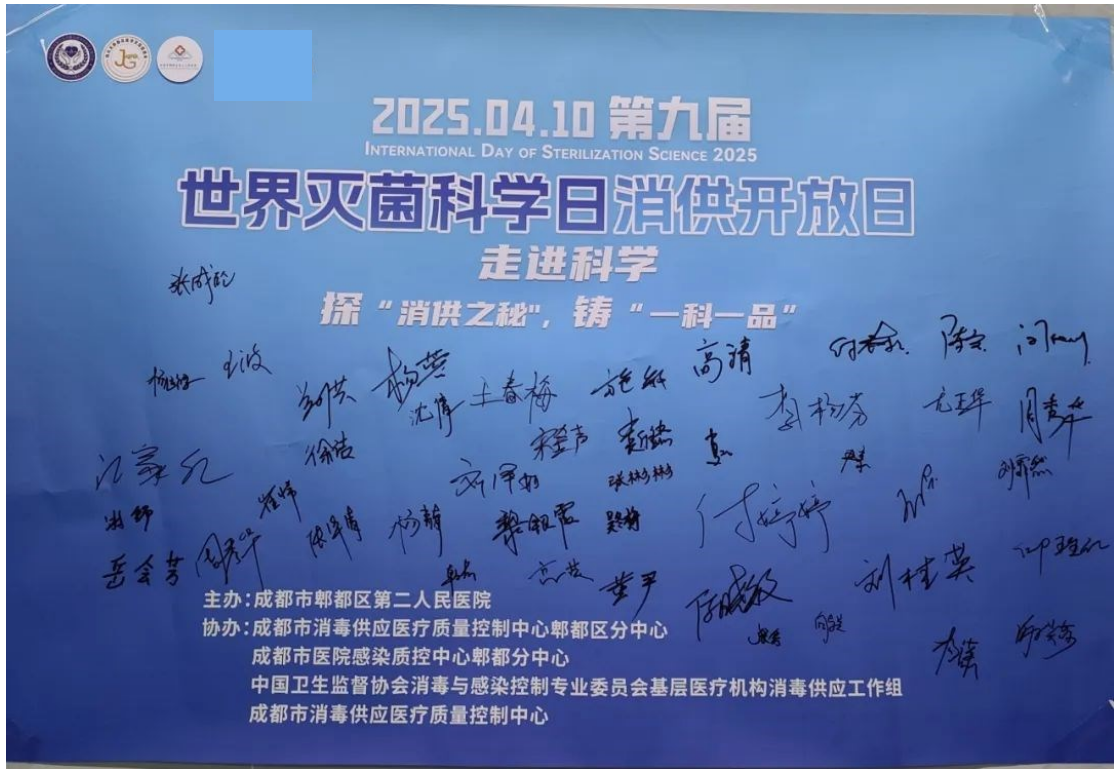

### Lectures
